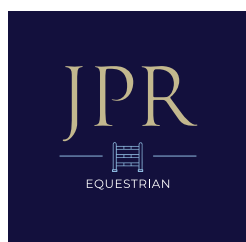

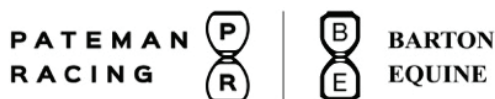

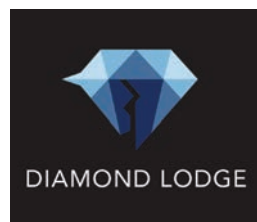

## Nominations to be done on Global Entries Online

Entries open 7.00pm Wednesday 27 September 2023  
and close on Friday 20 October 2023 at 10am.

- 1 **This event is run under EA/FEI rules & regulations.** EA Jumping Rules 1 July 2023, FEI Jumping Rules 1 January 2023, EA (FEI) WC Rules 1 January 2023. Including the following:
  - a. FEI Code of Conduct for the Welfare of the Horse
  - b. EA Code of Conduct for Conflict of Interest
  - c. FEI Code of Conduct for Jumping Warm Up Arenas
  - d. EA Code of Conduct
  - e. Australian Helmet Standards
  - f. Age Rules including Junior and Young Rider
  - g. Amateur Rules
- 2 All riders competing at the event will be deemed to have read and **accepted the Conditions of Entry**, as evidenced by ticking the Agree Box prior to completion of your entry on Global Entries Online.
- 3 **After any fall anywhere** at SIEC, the rider must present to the Medical Services Provider to be cleared BEFORE re-mounting. A rider falling voluntarily ie jumping off, anywhere outside the competition arena does not have to report to the MSP. Art 224
- 4 **The OC reserves the right to change or amend the program at its discretion.**
- 5 **The OC reserves the right to accept or refuse any entry.**
- 6 All owners and competitors will be personally responsible for damages to any third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their animals.
- 7 **Draw Order** – for both rings is expected.
  - a. Ring 1 takes priority
  - b. In certain classes in the Prydes Easifeed Arena 2, some leeway for senior riders competing in Ring 1 will be allowed for.
  - c. The Marshall in Ring 2 needs to be alerted to possible clashes.
  - d. **Do Not Assume** that you can come when you like in the Pryde's Easifeed Arena.
  - e. Should a horse need to be moved down the draw for exceptional reasons eg the loss of a shoe, the marshal shall communicate with the Judge to request a change in draw position.
- 8 **All riders must be current financial full members of EA.**
- 9 **Championship or Series**  
A horse can only enter one Title or Series.
- 10 **Any person competing in a class, must have a registration in that class either via Global Entries Online.** There can be no substitution of rider or horse once a Championship or Series has started.

- 11     **The OC reserves the right to swab horses.**
- 
- 12     **Refunds:** Refunds will be given in full before close of entries, less a \$50 administration fee, please contact the OC as refunds are not done automatically. After entries have closed, a 50% refund on class entries and stable fees will be given on presentation of a veterinary or doctor's certificate. There will be no refunds on the portable stables once entries have closed.
- 
- 13     **Incorrect Entries** – if an entry is incorrect at Close of Entries, an admin fee of \$25/incorrect entry will be incurred. This includes incorrect horse/rider combinations.
- 
- 14     **Presentation of Prizes**
- a.     Presentations in both rings will always be mounted
  - b.     Riders are expected to wear their jackets.
  - c.     In Ring 1 – riders are expected to be in every presentation.
  - d.     In the Prydes Easifeed Arena – a representative for the rider must be present if the rider is competing in Ring 1
- 
- 15     **Dress** – Formal dress rules apply. Riders will be permitted to remove their jackets at the direction of the Ground Jury Art 256 1.3
- 
- 16     **Dogs & Prams**
- a.     Dogs must be on a lead at all times
  - b.     Dogs are not allowed:
    - i.     In the warm up arena
    - ii.    Walking the course
  - c.     Prams are not allowed:
    - i.     In the warm up arena
    - ii.    Walking the course
  - d.     Failure to abide by this may result in elimination
- 
- 17     **Protests** - Must be addressed to the Ground Jury in writing and accompanied by a \$150 fee and can be lodged no later than 30 minutes after the announcement of the results of the relevant class.
- 
- 18     **Young Horse Boot Rule** – For any class or section of a class with an age requirement or limitation, the YH Boot Rule will apply – includes Futurity Classes.
- 
- 19     **GST** – is included in all fees and charges, and prize money.
- 
- 20     **Prize money** – will be paid through Global Entries Online, please upload your banking details into your Profile.
- 
- 21     **Opal Series**
- a.     Riders are now permitted to enter the Young Horse Section of the Opal Series if they are entered in other Series or Championships.
  - b.     Riders in the Opal Series Adult Section are not permitted to enter any other Series or Championship
  - c.     Junior Riders are now permitted to enter the Opal Series – Junior Section as well as either the Junior or Children's Championships
  - d.     A horse is still NOT permitted to enter more than 1 Series or Championship.

## 22 Australian Teams - Junior, Young Rider & Senior Teams

- a. Scored from Round 1 (or the one round class of the championship) and the first round of Round 2 (Jump off class of the championship).
  - b. Nominations from the State branches must be received by **Monday 30 October** in writing by email to [edwena@emcater.com.au](mailto:edwena@emcater.com.au)
  - c. Rugs and ribbons to the winning teams in each division – ribbons to 2nd and 3rd placed teams.
- 

## 23 Championships (Children's, Junior, Young Rider and Senior)

- **The Rules for the Children's, Junior, Young Rider & Senior Championships** are stated in the EA National Jumping rules effective 1 July 2023, Chapter 14.
  - **There is a Block Entry for the Children's, Junior, Young Rider & Senior Championships.** The Block Entry includes the two qualifying classes and the Final Class for those that qualify for that Final.
  - There will be Junior and Young Rider Consolation Classes.
  - **Each Championship is based on the combination**, if a rider or a horse is injured part way through a Championship or Series – neither horse nor rider can be substituted.
- 

## 24 Series (The Rider's Cup, Futurity, Ruby, Sapphire, Emerald, Amateur, TSHA and Opal)

- **Acceptance Fee**  
For all Series, the entry fee covers Round 1 and Round 2. An acceptance fee will be charged for riders who qualify for the Final Rounds of each Series.
  - **Each Series is based on the combination**, if a rider or a horse is injured part way through a Championship or Series – neither horse nor rider can be substituted.
- 

## 25 Mandatory stabling

- For Senior, Young Rider, Riders' Cup and Futurity horses
  - From the day of the Arrival Fitness Inspection to the conclusion of the relevant Final Round (for those horses that qualify for the Finals).
  - Therefore, horses in the four (4) classes requiring Mandatory Stabling are NOT ALLOWED off the grounds from the time of the Arrival Fitness Inspection to the conclusion of the Final Round.
- 

26 **Bridle Numbers** will need to be worn and displayed at all times. Bridle Number allocations will be done by the OC and emailed to competitors before the Arrival Fitness Inspection

## 27 Method of scoring for all Championships and Series

*Scoring Art 14 3.5 (EA National Jumping Rules 1 July 2023)*

**Allocation of Points for the First and Second Qualifying Competitions:** The winner of each Competition gets one point more than the number of starters in the First Qualifying Competition. The second placed gets two points less than the winner, the third placed three points less than the winner, and so on.

**Athletes eliminated or retiring:** Athletes who have been eliminated or have retired in the initial round of the first two Competitions do not get points.

**Equality of points among Athletes:** Points won by Athletes who are tied are added up and divided equally. Fractions of 0.5 and more are rounded up; fractions of less than 0.5 are rounded down.



**Transformation of points to penalties:** After the Second Qualifying Competition points are transformed into penalties. The Athlete with the highest number of points after the two Competitions will have 0 penalties. For all other Athletes the number of penalties will be calculated by multiplying with the coefficient of 0.50 the difference between their number of points and the points of the leading Athlete after the two Competitions. In this procedure all decimals are rounded down.

**Classification:** The overall Champion will be the Athlete with the lowest number of penalties after the three Competitions. An Athlete who qualifies for Round B of the third and Final Competition but who does not start in Round B will be ranked equal with other Athletes who started in Round B and are eliminated or retired in Round B of the Final Competition. If Athletes are tied for first place after the three Competitions, there will be a jump-off against the clock over a reduced course of at least six obstacles. In case of equality of penalties and time in this jump-off a second jump-off, against the clock, will be held over the same course. Athletes not in the jump-off but tying on penalties will be separated for the purpose of the Final overall classification by their time in the second round of the Third Competition.

**Starting order for Second Qualifying Competition and Final:** In the Second Qualifying Competition, the starting order is according to the reverse order of points allocated after the First Qualifying Competition. The starting order in Rounds A and B of the Third Competition is, respectively, according to the reverse order of penalties (i.e. points transformed into penalties) after the second Qualifying Competition, and after Round A of the Third Competition. Athletes with equality of points (after the first Qualifying Competition) or penalties (after the second Qualifying Competition or after Round A of the Third Competition) will retain the same starting order among themselves as in the previous Competition or round, whichever is applicable.

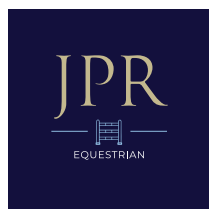

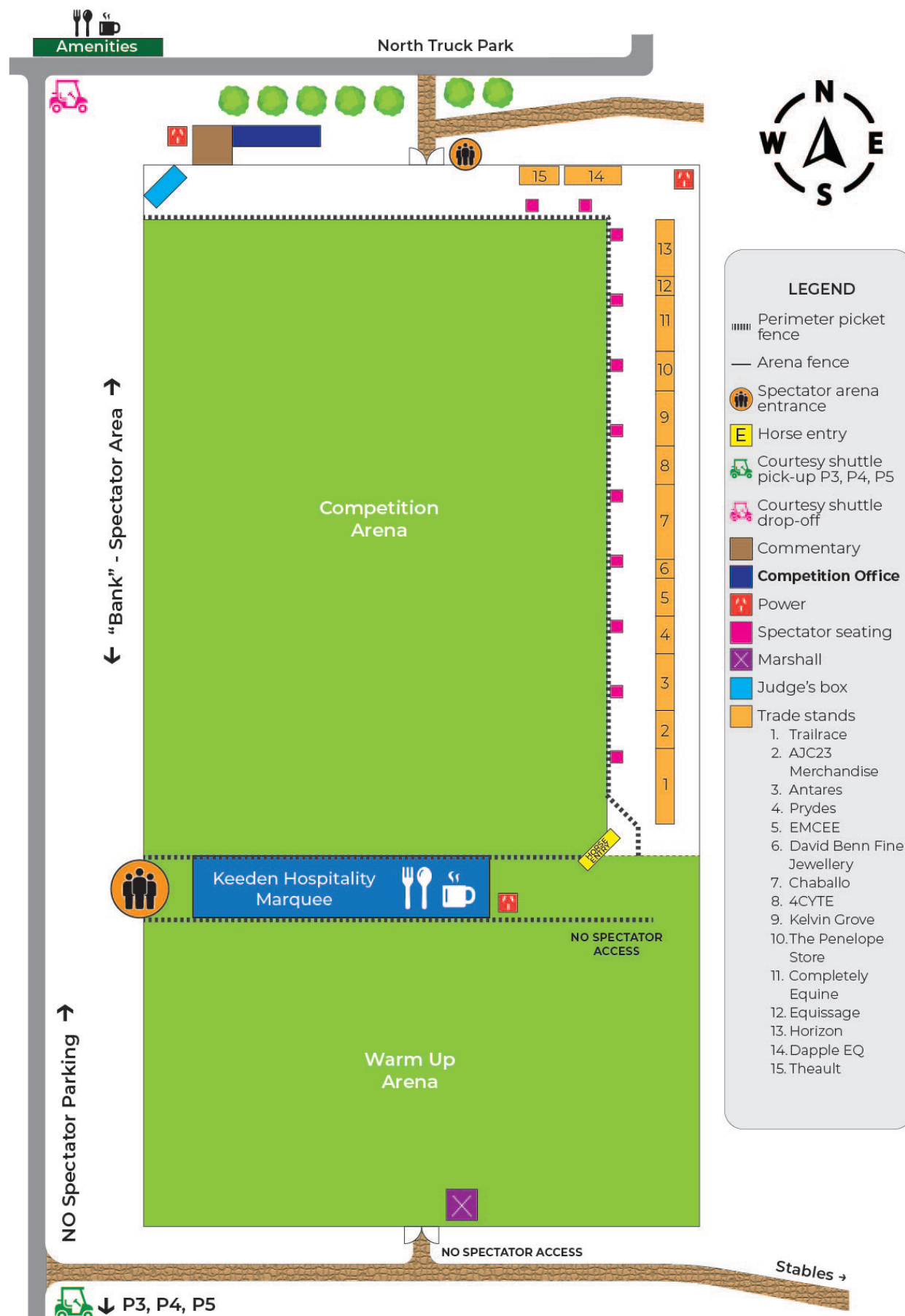
